## Protect Your Egg

This can be played as a family. You will need the following materials per person or per team.

- Raw egg
- Container, like a cardboard tube, cup, box, etc.
- Balloons, rubber bands, craft sticks, straws
- 4 a4 sheets of paper, etc.
- Pen or pencil
- Tape
- 4 pieces of string
- Scissors

You have 10 mins to design protection for your egg that will be dropped from varying heights – chest height, from standing on a chair, top floor window (if not possible it can be thrown in the air. Winner is the egg that survives the highest drop.

## Questions and reflections

Gravity is what makes the egg fall.
