How far away is the beach?

The beach is less than a five minute walk away down a track. It takes a bit longer to get back as it's uphill!

How many people can you fit in each tent?

The tents are bell tents with a central pole that sleep about 5/6 adults.

Do the tents have electricity?

No the tents don't have electricity.

Is there somewhere to charge mobile phones?

Yes, you are able to charge mobile phones in the marquee.

How far are the tents from the shower block / toilets?

The toilet blocks and showers are a few minutes' walk away from the tents.

Are showers available?

Yes there are heated unisex cubicled showers available...be aware they are outdoors

Is there hot running water?

Yes in the toilets and washing up area.

Can we dry clothes on site?

There is a washing line to peg clothes on to dry them.

Can you drive up to the tents to unpack luggage?

Yes you are able to drive into the field to unpack your car. You are also able to take your car up to your tent at the end of the holiday to pack up.

Where do you leave your car overnight?

We kindly ask that you park your cars in the bottom field near the marquees whilst on site.

Where do we eat meals?

All meals are eaten at shared tables in a marquee.

Are special diets catered for?

Yes, please just inform us when you book.

Can you store food in the kitchen?

Unfortunately it is not possible to store your own food in the kitchen. However, we do make exceptions to this if you have a special diet or need to store baby food.

Can you store ice packs in the freezer?

Yes there is room in the freezer for ice packs (clearly named please).

Can we make drinks when we want?

Yes, there is access to a cold and hot water urn in the marquee and tea and coffee is available at all times.

Can you drink alcohol on site?

Yes alcohol drunk in moderation is allowed on site outside of tents only.

Are their highchairs on site?

There are no high chairs on site.

Do you need to bring crockery?

All crockery and cutlery will be provided. You may wish to bring a drinks bottle to fill if going out for the day.

Are you expected to wash up after meals?

We ask for some volunteers to help clear tables and wash up after every meal. We have a commercial dishwasher which someone is specifically trained to use but ask for help loading and unloading it.

Can you bring a dog?

Dogs are not allowed to stay overnight on site.

Can you smoke on site?

No, it is a completely non smoking site.

Are there organised activities available?

There is a short family devotional time / thought for the day each morning, which everyone is invited to if they want to come. There are a few optional activities planned for the evenings, such as a quiz, campfire and film night. There are no organised activities planned for during the day, most families go out for the day or to the beach. There are a few games on site, a table tennis table and table football.

What do I need to bring with me?

You need to bring a camping mat/bed to sleep on, sleeping bag, torch, refillable drinks bottle, beach equipment, camping chairs and anything else that may enhance your camping experience!
