Walking on water

Jesus insisted that his disciples get back into the boat and cross to the other side of the lake, while he sent the people home. After sending them home, he went up into the hills by himself to pray. Night fell while he was there alone.

Meanwhile, the disciples were in trouble far away from land, for a strong wind had risen, and they were fighting heavy waves. About three o'clock in the morning Jesus came toward them, walking on the water. When the disciples saw him walking on the water, they were terrified. In their fear, they cried out, "It's a ghost!"

But Jesus spoke to them at once. "Don't be afraid," he said. "Take courage. I am here!"



Then Peter called to him, "Lord, if it's really you, tell me to come to you, walking on the water."

"Yes, come," Jesus said. So Peter went over the side of the boat and walked on the water toward Jesus. But when he saw the strong wind and the waves, he was terrified and began to sink. "Save me, Lord!" he shouted. Jesus immediately reached out and grabbed him. "You have so little faith," Jesus said. "Why did you doubt me?"

When they climbed back into the boat, the wind stopped. Then the disciples worshiped him. "You really are the Son of God!" they exclaimed.

PETER walks on the water



- Watercolour paint




• Write out this verse on the paper using the white wax crayon:

Trust games

Peter trusted Jesus - you can play these trust games

Feely box

You will need:

- A box with a hole or a cover over it or a draw-string bag
- Items to place inside (suggestions: ball, toy, stone, stick) try to pick some natural and some man-made objects and objects with different textures, rough and smooth.

How to play:

Place all the objects in the bag / box

Take turns to feel inside the bag, pick an object and guess what it is before you remove it from the bag.

Blind tasting

You will need:

Suitable items for tasting! For example...

- Marmite
- Salt
- Sugar
- Salad cream
- Mayo
- Crisps of different flavours
- Or you could use different sweets!

A blindfold

How to play:

- Put the items on plates or in small dishes
- Put a blindfold on one person
- The other person gives a dish to the other to taste, see how many you can guess.
- Take turns, see who can get the most right



Stepping stones

You will need:

- A newspaper or magazine or individual pieces of paper enough for each person to stand on
- Or you could also draw around your feet (and write a prayer of thanks on each one)

How to play:

- Work together as a team to get from one end of the room/garden to the other
- Stand behind one another in a line stand on your piece of paper
- Pass the last persons paper down the line to the front
- The front person moves forward onto that piece
- Everyone moves up one place and stands on the paper
- Continue to pass the paper from the back to the front and move across the room or garden till you have all safely reached the other side.
