Engagement Team:	This includes Prayer, Communications, and Fundraising.
People Team:	This includes Safeguarding, HR (Human Relations), Development and Training.
Additional Needs Ministry:	The aim of our Additional Needs Ministry is to encourage, enable and equip children's, youth and families' workers to reach, include, create belonging for, and disciple all children and young people, especially those with additional needs or disabilities.
Conference:	Meeting of all the Urban Saints paid Team.
Energize:	Our resources website loaded with teaching materials and articles.
Regional Prayer Coordinators:	Those appointed to set up a prayer group in their nation or region; to contact Group Leaders for prayer news and circulate this to prayer supporters by email and/or post.
